## **Motorist**

Bicyclists have the same rights to the road as motorists and must obey the same rules.

### **As the Motorist, you Must:**

- Yield right-of-way to a cyclist just as you would yield to another vehicle. (This means not pulling out in front of a moving cyclist or cutting them off.)
- Allow a safe distance when passing a cyclist: at least 3 feet to the side
- Only pass when you can see far enough ahead to complete the pass without interfering with the safe operation of any vehicle or bicycle
- Obey the speed limit
- Pay attention to your driving

# Bicyclist

Bicyclists have the same rights to the road as motorists and must obey the same rules.

## As the Bicyclist, you Must:

- Stop for stop signs and red lights
  - Ride with, not against traffic
  - Signal stops, sideways movements and turns
- 
- Yield to vehicles and other bicycles when you do not have right-of-way
  - Not ride on sidewalks or crosswalks. (They're for pedestrians.)
  - Use a white front headlight and red rear reflector after dark
  - Wear a helmet

Maximize your visibility and predictability. Ride where motorists can see you. Obey the law.
