As the Bicyclist, you MUST

- Stop for stop signs and red lights
- Ride with, not against traffic
- Yield to vehicles and other bicycles when you do not have the right-of-way
- Not ride on sidewalks or crosswalks
- Use a white front headlight and a red rear reflector after dark

Maximize your visibility and predictability

- -- See and be seen -- Avoid hazards
- -- Prevent squeeze pass -- Prepare for left turn -- Lane too narrow to share


